- the 5th destination for EU agri-food exports in the world (€6.4 billion)
- a large and wealthy market (130 million consumers)
- growing demand for EU high quality products

## THE EU-JAPAN EPA WILL BENEFIT THE EU AGRI-FOOD SECTOR THROUGH:

- a greater market access (elimination of tariffs and non-tariff barriers) and an enhanced competitiveness in the Asia-pacific region
- a high level of protection of Geographical Indications (GIs)
- an in-depth cooperation between EU and Japan on agri-food related issues

## GREATER MARKET ACCESS FOR EU PRODUCTS TO JAPAN



85% of EU agri-food products exported to Japan will be liberalised in the coming years

Wine and sparkling wines	-	Duty free from day one of the agreement
Hard cheeses (parmigiano reggiano, comté, gouda	a, etc.)	Duty free
<b>Soft cheeses</b> (mozzarella, feta, camembert, etc.)	<b>→</b>	Duty free quota with volume increase
Beef meat	-	Significant duty reduction
Pigmeat and processed (sausages, ham, etc.)	<b>+</b>	Duty free or quasi duty free

Processed fruit and vegetables (processed tomatoes, jams, etc.)	<b>→</b>	Duty free
Fruit and vegetables	<b>→</b>	Duty reduction
