





## Summary:

- Total imports of soya beans +12% Y/Y at 6,952,645 tonnes;
- Compared to the first 27 weeks of the 2017/18 marketing year (July to December), EU imports of soya beans from the United States are up by 112% at 5,181,833 tonnes;
- In terms of the EU's total imports of soya beans the U.S. share is now at 75%, compared to 39% in in the same period last year;
- US prices for soya beans are still the most competitive on the market

### Technical notes:

- Marketing year (MY) from 1 July to 30 June
- Provisional trade data based on notified customs declaration through the TAXUD Surveillance system. Data for the 2018/19 MY are expected to be revised upwards after receving the final notifications from the customs authorities.
- The weekly reference period is from Monday to Sunday (starting from 1 July)
- The first 27 weeks of the MY: for the 2018/19 MY from 1/07/2018 to 30/12/2018; for the 2017/18 MY from 1/07/2017 to 31/12/2017
